Expectations & experiences include:

- Connecting with other recipients and staff in advance- pre-planning of the Scholarship Showcase Dance.
- Arriving prepared for participation as a caller or musician in the 90-minute Sunday Scholarship Showcase Dance.
- Shadowing and/or accessing staff musicians & callers when appropriate opportunities arise.
- Providing a brief written self-reflection regarding the Ralph Page Dance Weekend experience by February 1, 2020.
