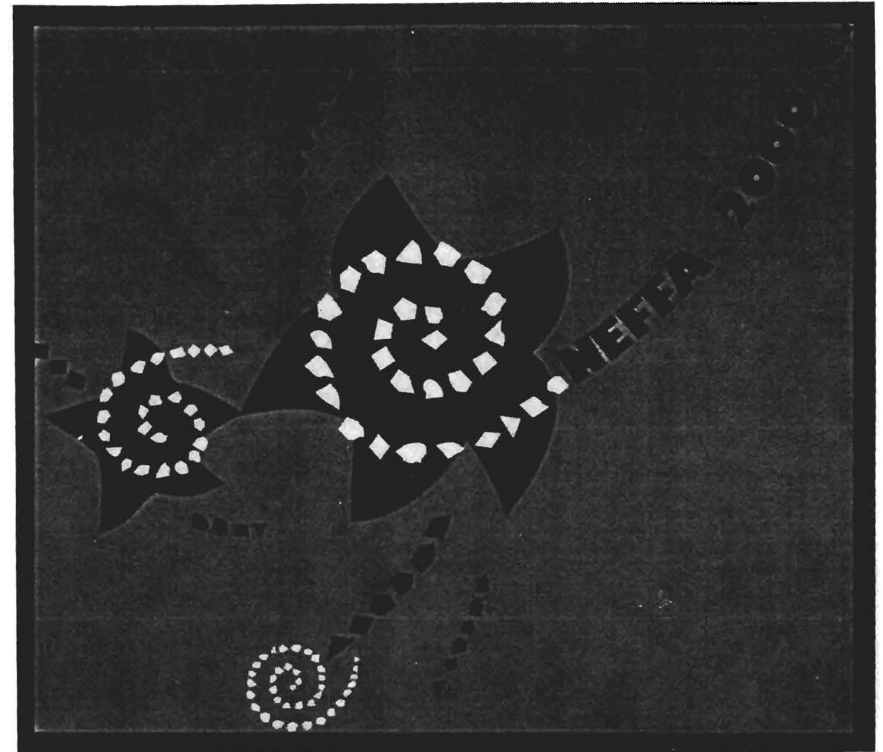


The floor plan illustrates the layout of the Lyric Theatre for the NEFA Souvenirs and Crafts Fair. Key areas include:

- Rest Area:** A designated space for performers and volunteers.
- Auditorium:** The main performance space, featuring a stage and a North Star Room.
- Other Rooms:** Includes a Music Room, Chorus Room, and a South Room.

FESTIVAL NOTES

Please wear only clean, non-marking shoes which have not been worn outside (such as clean sneakers or soft-soled dance shoes) in the Main Hall, Lower Hall and Auditorium Stage.

There is no on-street parking associated with the Festival -- avoid frustration by parking at US Army Lots off Rt. 27 in Natick. Shuttle buses run every 15 minutes between all the remote parking lots and the high school throughout the weekend.

Park at your own risk. The New England Folk Festival Association, its agents, servants and employees do not assume any liability for any damage, theft or other loss to your vehicle or your property that occurs as a result of parking your vehicle in any of the lots that are designated for Festival use. Overnight parking is not permitted in any of the lots used for Festival parking. Observe the designated NEFFA parking signs.

NEFFA will not be making announcements about towing.

Access Guides for attendees with disabilities are available in the Lobby and at the Hospitality Table. The Guides include wheelchair accessibility information, and information about certain sessions which offer ASL and ALD services, etc. **Large print grids** are available in the Lobby and at the Hospitality Table. Be sure to check the wall grids for last minute schedule changes. Please contact Hospitality if you need assistance with access to a program or activity.

Children must be supervised by a parent or guardian **at all times.** Events coded **F** are designed for you and your children to participate in together. However, any Festival Committee member who finds a small child alone will bring him/her to the Hospitality Table to await his/her parent. Parents may report small children who are missing to the Hospitality Table. The New England Folk Festival Association, its agents, servants and employees do not assume any liability for any injuries to a child sustained as a result of parent or guardian's failure to adequately supervise a child at the Festival.

Questions? Can't find the Auditorium Stage? Lost your ticket? Need a ride? Want to leave a message for a friend? Ask for help at the **Hospitality Table**, or stop one of the Festival Committee members who are wearing special badges. Probably no one person can answer all your questions, but we'll help you find the right place to ask.

NEFFA encourages all dancers to exercise care in their dancing. The New England Folk Festival Association, its agents, servants and employees do not assume any liability for any injuries that may be sustained due to the condition of the halls or the dancing.

NEFFA maintains a **Lost & Found** at the **Hospitality Table**. Before you leave the Festival, check at the Hospitality Table to report belongings you have mislaid. The item may already be there. If not, and it is found at the close of the Festival, it will be mailed to you, if we have your name and address. If you discover after you leave the Festival that you have lost something, you may call (508) 229-2854 to see if the item was found. Items not claimed by July first will be donated to charity, if appropriate.

NEFFA maintains a telephone number at the Festival **for emergency incoming calls only**. In the event you need to contact someone **in an emergency only**, call (508) 229-2854 and the staff at the Hospitality Table will endeavor to assist you. Since the Festival is so large, we can't guarantee we'll be able to locate an attendee, but we'll do our best.

NEFFA does not permit Festival-goers to bring **dogs or other animals on the Natick High School property** during the Festival, except animals which are present for the purpose of assisting someone with a disability. Dogs found alone on the Natick High School property will be reported to the Natick dog officer.

We thank the U.S. Army for their generous donation of additional parking. See maps for parking locations. There will be frequent shuttle buses between the parking lots and the Festival site.

Please watch your personal belongings. The New England Folk Festival Association, its agents, servants and employees do not assume any liability for any damage, theft or loss to your personal property that occurs as a result of attendance at the Festival.

This is an all-volunteer Festival, so be sympathetic if the program gets off schedule or someone goofs. We invite your patience and hope you will join the fun and friendliness.

Please smile if one of our safety volunteers asks you to move out of a jammed doorway, or not to sit in the bleacher aisles. Public safety laws demand that these conditions be addressed at all times.

Smoking is not allowed anywhere on the school property.

Festival craftspeople, merchants and those who serve food come at their own expense to share their interests with others. Do consider buying items that are for sale, but remember that the transactions are entirely between you and the vendors.

Food must be eaten in the cafeteria, and is not permitted in any of the other rooms or hallways of the High School. Sealed water bottles, such as sports bottles, are permitted, but must remain sealed when not in use.

A rest area is available for Festival-goers – please see the NEFFA map to find it. The South Room is available for **jamming, rehearsals, and other informal activities**. A sign-up sheet will be posted on the door to reserve this room. (Please note that this room is not wheelchair accessible. See the **Access Guide** for alternatives.)

Membership in NEFFA entitles you to voting privileges, attendance at NEFFA Executive Board meetings, the *NEFFA News* sent to you four times a year, and reduced admission to the NEFFA Festival.

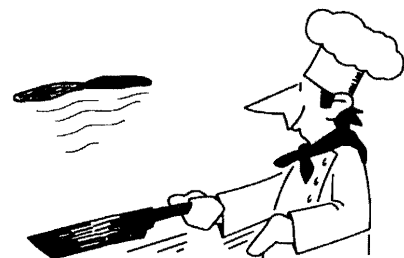

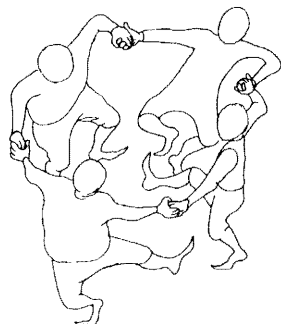
