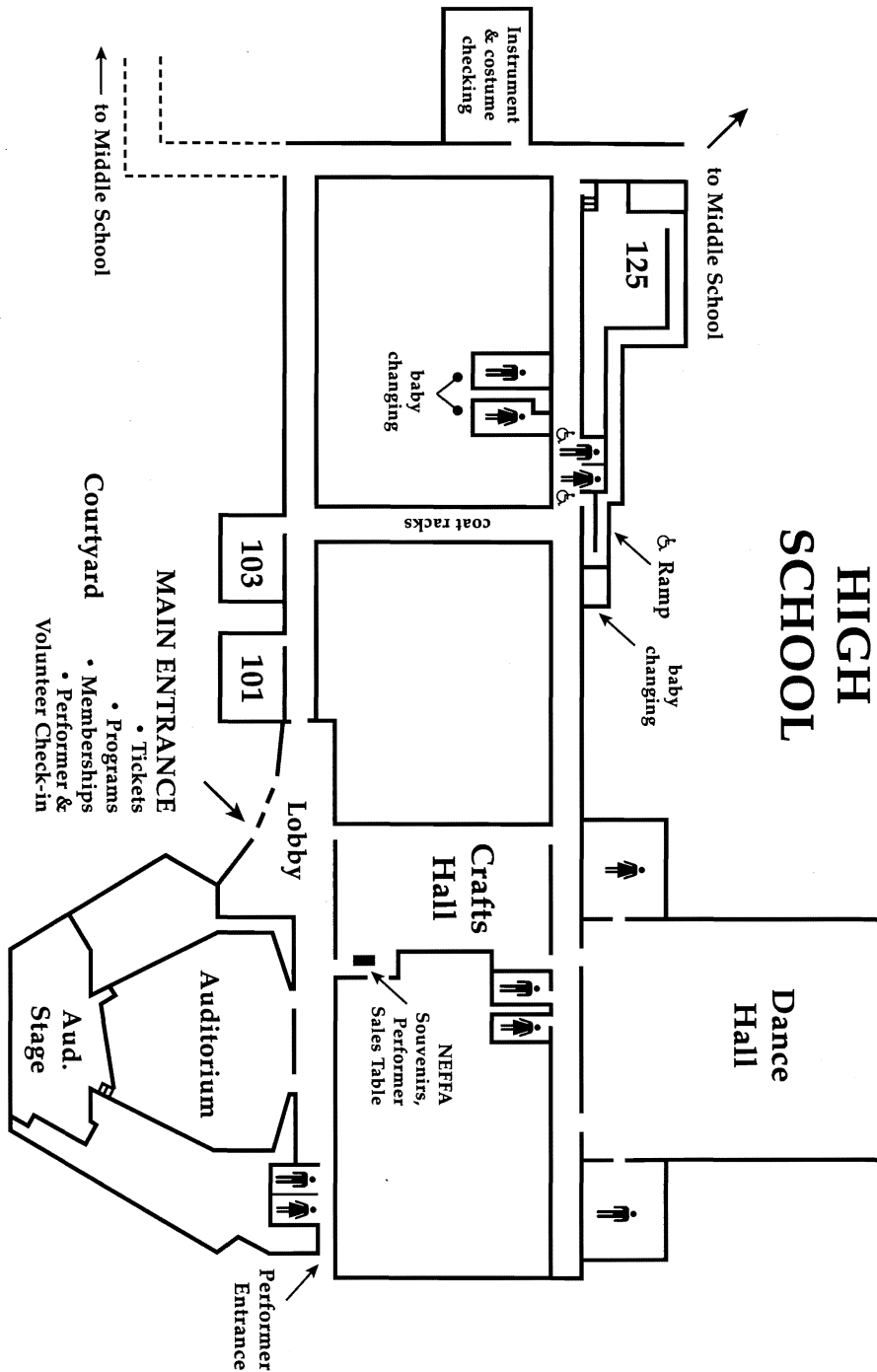

Moving NEFFA to a new site presents many opportunities as well as a few new constraints.

One of those new constraints is a requirement from the Mansfield Fire Department that we don't exceed the designated capacities of the rooms that we are using. The capacities of the gymnasiums and auditoriums are large enough that it's unlikely that we would exceed the limits for any of the events which are scheduled. The rooms that we're using for the Folk Music and Song events, however, are classrooms, and the specified capacities for their use are as classrooms, not for use as concert and workshop venues. As a result, the specified maximum capacities of these rooms range from 36 people to 78 people, which is somewhat less than the capacities of the rooms we used for these events at Natick.

An Important Note About ROOM CAPACITY

While it shouldn't be a problem for most events, there will still be some that will draw an audience that exceeds the room capacity. To insure that we don't exceed the room capacities, we're taking the following actions:

The capacity of each room will be posted outside of each room.

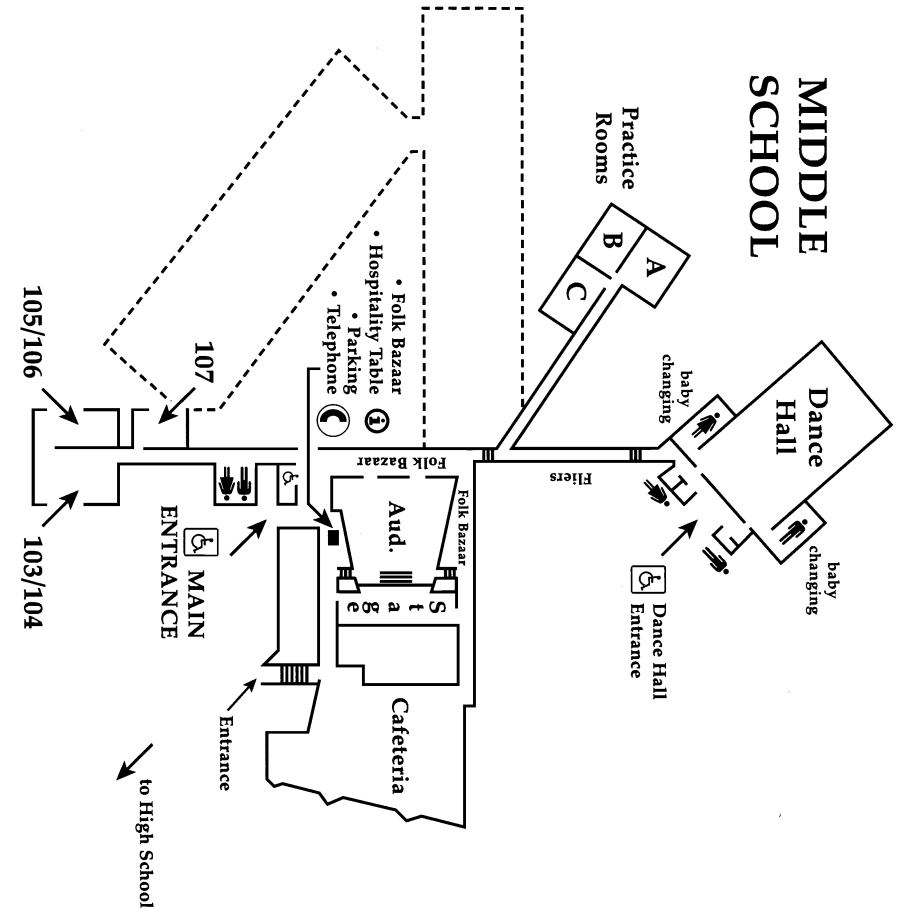
The number of chairs placed in each room will be equal to the room capacity.

For events that are likely to draw a large audience, there will be room monitors stationed at the entrance who will not allow any more people into a room once the capacity is reached.

If you are not allowed into an event because the room capacity has been reached, please be understanding and cooperate with the room monitor.

Mansfield looks like it will be a wonderful new home for NEFFA in so many ways, but our continued use of the Mansfield schools is contingent on our enforcing these new room capacity rules and constraints.

LETTER

FROM THE PRESIDENT

Welcome to the 63rd annual New England Folk Festival. Congratulations on finding your way to us at our exciting new location in Mansfield, a big change after many years at Natick High School. Thank you for coming to enjoy whichever activities attract you from our offerings of vocal and instrumental music, performance and participatory dance, admiring and purchasing crafts and folk products, as well eating and socializing in the cafeteria.

If you are new to the Festival, you are especially welcome. The grid indicates which programs are for beginners or families. You can find a participatory dance to join at your experience level, enjoy concerts, storytelling or dance performances, or join singing, jamming or discussion sessions. You can also visit the Crafts Room, Folk Bazaar and Cafeteria.

The essence of the "Folk Tradition" that we are a part of is that most of our programs are for the whole community that comes. While each event is not for everyone, there are dozens of activities that will suit anyone interested in folk traditions. Feel free to ask questions of all the people you see with organizers' badges, and for that matter, most other Festival attendees. We folkies tend to be the sociable sort and love to share our knowledge and enthusiasm about what goes on here.

This is an exciting and challenging time for NEFFA. We are thrilled to be starting what we hope will be a long-term association with the town of Mansfield, many of whose employees have already made us feel very welcome. It has been a long and expensive process to accomplish this move, so please support the organization by becoming a member and making tax deductible

donations to the New England Folk Festival, Inc. Though approximately seven thousand people usually come to the Festival, and thousands more attend our dances, only a few hundred are currently members. For \$20 per individual, or \$38 per family, you would receive our newsletter and discounts on admission, but most of all, you get the satisfaction of supporting an organization that is dedicated to promoting the traditions that you love. Admission fees do not cover all our expenses, and we don't wish to raise prices much, as that would exclude some people from coming.

As we are new in Mansfield and using a two-building site for the first time, we ask for your help as we sort out the issues that come up. One big change is that the occupancy limits for classroom performance spaces are to be strictly enforced by the Mansfield Fire Department, so please help us by planning your festival activities so you have fun alternatives, in case your first choice is not available because the room is full.

Our performers, organizers, artists and staff are all volunteers. This magical weekend happens because of the dedication of well over a thousand committed workers. Once again, if you would like to join the volunteers in the year-long preparation for the Festival, or to work during it, please provide your name and contact information on an evaluation form and we will be in touch. There is a delightful sense of accomplishment at being part of a real-life "Brigadoon," transforming an ordinary high school to a buzzing, joyous folk festival for one magical weekend.

EVENT CODES

TYPE OF EVENT

[E] Entertainment

Concerts, performances, and other events in which watching or listening is the primary focus.

[P] Presentations

Events which focus on demonstrating a particular skill, or presenting educational material (as in a lecture or demonstration).

[G] Group participation

As determined by the event leader. this applies in particular to *non-dance* events, such as participatory singing, jam sessions, discussions, and many family events.

[T] Teaching featured

Events in which teaching a particular skill is the primary focus (i.e., "how-to" workshops).

[D] Participatory dancing

Dance events in which walk-throughs and prompting are provided by a leader.

[N] No teaching provided

Participatory dance events in which no instruction or walk-throughs are provided.

[C] Chat/Discussion

Events in which the audience joins the presenter in discussing a topic of mutual interest.

LEVEL OF EVENT

(intended level of experience or ability, especially for participatory dance and teaching events)

[F] Family Event

Participatory events especially geared to families and others who enjoy being with children.

[B] Beginner Level

No experience assumed.

[M] Mixed Level

Some experience, or a variety of experience levels assumed.

[X] Experienced Level

Much experience assumed.

FESTIVAL NOTES

Please wear only clean, non-marking shoes which have not been worn outside (such as clean sneakers or soft-soled dance shoes) in the dance halls and on the auditorium stages.

There is no on-street parking associated with the Festival -- avoid frustration by parking at the **school lots or other designated parking areas**. Shuttle buses run regularly between all the satellite parking lots and the Mansfield schools throughout the weekend. See maps for parking locations.

Park at your own risk. The New England Folk Festival Association, its agents, servants and employees do not assume any liability for any damage, theft or other loss to your vehicle or your property that occurs as a result of parking your vehicle in any of the lots that are designated for Festival use. Neither overnight parking nor camping is permitted on school grounds or in any of the lots used for Festival Parking. Observe the designated NEFFA parking signs.
